Forest Intelligence Cell (FIC) of the Kerala Forest Department is exercising strict vigil against forest offences especially offences related to wildlife trafficking and illegal trade of wildlife articles across the state. From 25.04.2015 to 17.06.2016 the FIC had under took 25 undercover operations and seized wildlife articles including Elephant tusk, teeth, leopard skin, claws, Tiger skin, leopard cat pelt, live specimen of scheduled animals including Sand boa, Indian Black Shelled Turtle, Pangolin, Star tortoise which were kept illegally and put to trade from different parts of the State. They could also seize Bear meat oil, Sandal wood, Porcupine meat, Wild boar meat during these operations. In this connection 35 offenders have been arrested and also seized 17 vehicles used for the transport of the above said articles & forest produce. For the above mentioned seizures 24 forest offences were booked in different territorial & wildlife circles of the State. The exemplary performance of the FIC could be attributed to the dedicated services of a handful of forest personnel associated with the Wing. The commitment, enthusiasm & perseverance shown by Sri. V.Anilkumar, Beat Forest Officer is especially praiseworthy as he had played a pivotal role in gathering the initial intelligence and decoying the unsuspecting out laws to submission. He has played a very crucial role in flawlessly carrying out the above mentioned undercover operations.

As a token of recognition of the good work done by Sri. V.Anilkumar, Beat Forest Officer and also as a measure of encouragement, it is decided to award "Good Service Entry" to him. I, P.K. Kesavan, Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Vigilance and Forest Intelligence), do here by order the awarding of "Good Service Entry" to Sri. V. Anilkumar, Beat Forest Officer, Forest Intelligence Cell.
