
**ORDER NO. D1-24434/14 DATED: 02-07-2015**

As per the orders read as 1<sup>st</sup> above, thirteen Range Forest Officers appointed from among the Deputy Range Officers were deputed for training as stipulated in Rule (9) (h) of the Kerala Forest Service Special Rules, 2010 at Kerala Forest School, Walayar. In order to avoid keeping these ranges vacant as it would adversely affect the smooth functioning of the offices, the temporarily appointed Range Forest Officers in the department were allowed to continue in their respective posts until the training was over. Government were requested to create fifteen supernumerary posts of trainee Range Forest Officers as training reserve for six months for imparting training to all the Range Forest Officers appointed from among the Deputy Range Officers. Pending Government decision, as per the order read as 2<sup>nd</sup> above, the salary for the month of March onwards for the nine junior most temporarily appointed Range Forest Officers who were working in the department in excess of the sanctioned post were ordered not to be drawn and disbursed until further orders. As per the letter read as 3<sup>rd</sup> above, Government have informed that the proposal for creation of supernumerary posts cannot be accepted. Hence the following nine junior most temporarily appointed Range Forest Officers are notionally reverted to the post of Deputy Range Officer with effect from 10.03.2015 i.e. the date of reporting for duty of the fifteen Range Forest

Officers after completing their practical training in the department and notionally promoted temporarily to the cadre of Range Forest Officer with effect from 08.06.2015 the date of order promoting ten Range Forest Officers as Assistant Conservator of Forests.

Now due to the retirement of Range Forest Officers and promotion of ten Range Forest Officers as Assistant Conservator of Forests vide Government order read as 4<sup>th</sup> above, enough vacancies have arisen in the department to accommodate the nine junior most temporarily appointed Range Forest Officers. In the above circumstances, during the period under reversion, the above said Range Forest Officers may draw their salary at the rate they were drawing it before they were promoted temporarily as Range Forest Officer.
