NOTIFICATION

No.76152/Ft-2/64/AD. Dated Thiruvananthapuram, 22nd February 1966

In the exercise of the powers conferred by section 19 of Kerala Forest Act, 1961 (Act 4 of 1962) and after having taken the proceedings prescribed in sections 4 to 18 of the said Act (both inclusive), the Government of Kerala hereby specify the limits mentioned in the schedule hereunto appended as the limits of Forest which it is intended to reserve and declare the said forest to be reserved from 10th March 1966.

SCHEDULE

Block No.I

Name of Block-Embakode Teak Plantation Block I.

Revenue District-Ernakulam

Taluk - Kunnathunad

Village – No.13, Cheranallur

Extent – 30 acres 47 cents

Situation-The land is situated south of Kapricad teak plantation reserve and comprises portions of survey Nos. 629/2A (6 cents), 629/2B (2 acres 51 cents), 630/1 (26 acres 86 cents), 632/3 (1 acre 4 cetns) of Charanallur Village, Kunnathunad Taluk.

BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION

North-(The Southern boundary of Kapricad Teak Plantation Reserve)

Starting from cairn No.51 at the northwest corner of survey No.632/3 the boundary goes northeast for about 4¾ chains to C. No.50, thence more or less east for about 6½ chains to C. No.49, thence east northeast for about 9 chains to cairn No.48, thence east slightly south for about 22½ chains passing C. Nos. 47 to 43 to C. No. 42, thence northeast for about 10¾ chains passing C. No.41 to C. No. 40A.

East – Thence south slightly east for about 4½ chains to C.No.40 of Kapricad Teak plantations.

South-Thence northwest for about 1 chain to C. No.1, thence west slightly south for about 6 chains passing cairn No.2 to C. No.3, thence southwest for about $3\frac{1}{2}$ chains passing C.No.4 and 5 to C.No.6 thence more or less west for about $7\frac{1}{4}$ chains passing C. No.7 to C.No.8, thence south slightly west for about $2\frac{1}{4}$ chains passing C. No.9 to C.No.10, thence more or less west for about $8\frac{1}{4}$ chains passing C.No.11 to C.No.11 to C.No.12, thence south for about $\frac{3}{4}$ chains passing C.No.14 and 15 to C.No.16.

West- Thence northwest for about $11\frac{1}{2}$ chains passing C.No.17 and 18 to C.No.19, thence west slightly north for about $5\frac{1}{4}$ chains along the southern limits of Kodanad-Panamkuzhi road, passing C.No.20 to C.No.21, thence south west for about 1 chain to C. No.22,(thence southeast for about $\frac{1}{2}$ chain to C.No.23, thence more or less south west for about $3\frac{1}{4}$ chains passing cairn No.24 to meet the starting point at C. No.51 of Kaprikad teak plantation.

Block II

Name of block – Embakode Teak Plantation Block II

Revenue District – Ernakulam

Taluk-Kunnathunad

Village-No.13 Cheranallur

Extent-7 acres and 60 cents

Situation- This block is situated south of Kaprikad Teak Plantation Reserve and to the east of Embakode thodu and comprises a portion of survey No.630/1 of Cheranallur Village, Kunnathunad Taluk.

BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION

North-Starting from C.No.38 of Kaprikad Teak plantation reserve, at the northwest corner of the block, the boundary runs east slightly south for about $3\frac{1}{2}$ chains to C. No.37, thence south east for about $10\frac{3}{4}$ chains crossing the Kodanad Panamkuzhi road and passing C.No.36 to C.No.35 of Kaprikad Teak Plantation.

East- Thence more or less south for about 4 chains along the eastern limit of survey No.630/1 passing C.No.1 to C.No.2. thence southwest for about 3 chains to C.No.3.

South- Thence northwest for about $2\frac{3}{4}$ chains passing C. No. 4 to C. No.5, thence west slightly north for about w chains to C.No.6, thence northwest for about $2\frac{1}{4}$ chains passing C. No.7 to C. No.8.

West- Thence north slightly east for about $4\frac{3}{4}$ chains, passing C.No.9 to C.No.10, thence northwest for about 6 chains passing C.No.9 to C.No.10, thence northwest for about 6 chains passing cairn No.11 to cairn No.38 at the starting point.
