



KARIMPANA (*Borassus flabellifer*)



Karimpana has been described by Tamil poets as Kalpavriksha.

Male palms are tapped for juice or sap, which is fermented and distilled to produce palm wine.

Leaves are used for thatching huts, making mats and fans.

Some of our old manuscripts are written in palm leaves known as Olai and they were written upon by an iron pen.
